Annual Report: 2022-2023

The academic year 2022-2023 was marked by a commitment to fostering a safe and respectful environment for all students at college. The Anti-Ragging Committee played a pivotal role in addressing incidents of misconduct and ensuring disciplinary actions were taken when necessary.

The Anti-Ragging Committee urgently convened on October 10, 2022 to address a fight between two students, as reported by second-year student Rithul against third-year student Firos. An inquiry committee was constituted to investigate the incident thoroughly and the principal instructed to submit the report after the enquiry.

Following the inquiry into the reported incident, the Anti-Ragging Committee reconvened on October 10, 2022, to decide on appropriate actions. It was determined that the accused students should be suspended with immediate effect, and their dismissal was strongly recommended.

Throughout the academic year, the Anti-Ragging Committee remained vigilant in upholding the institution's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and ensuring the safety and well-being of all students. The actions taken serve as a testament to our commitment to maintaining a conducive learning environment free from harassment and misconduct.
